This week, we have celebrated Chinese New Year by learning about the cultures and traditions of the celebration. The children have dressed in traditional dress in our Role Play area, looking at menus and learning how to use chopsticks.

Throughout the week, the children have been learning about the animal race and finding out which animal represents the year they were born. We discovered 2025 is the Year of the Snake and most of us (including Miss Wade & Mrs Byrne) were born in the Year of the Rat! We have made our own snakes, focusing on using tools to create different patterns.



EYFS have also explored writing their name using Chinese writing and worked together to make dancing dragons. The children have ended the week sampling spring rolls, noodles and prawn crackers. They all received a fortune cookie and a lucky red envelope.

We have worked together to make a dragon head ready to perform a dance. A huge thank you to Mrs Lau for coming into our class to tell us about her experiences of Chinese New Year traditions too.
