Help and support for Maths.

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To support your children with maths, remember that they can use the one-minute maths app from White Rose maths. This is a free app, and the children are remarkably familiar with it as we use it in school.

Year 1 children can practise their counting in twos, fives, and tens within the multiplication section on the app – Units 1,2,3.

Year 2 children can practise their times tables within the multiplication section on the app. We are also concentrating on twos, fives, and ten's units 8, 11 and 16.
