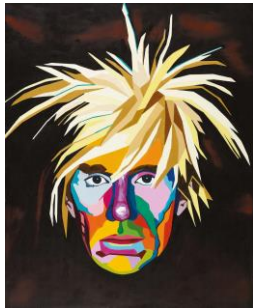

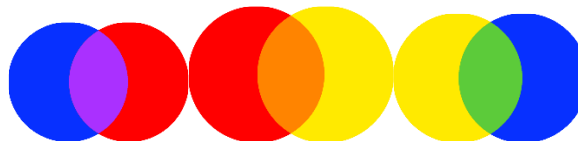

## Key Vocabulary

**Primary colours** - Red, yellow and blue.

**Hue** - Describing an exact colour: dark green, light blue.

**Mix**- combining two or more colours together.

**Pattern** - Pattern is a design in which shapes, colours or lines are repeated.

**Secondary colours** - orange, green and purple and these are made by mixing primary colours together.

**Paint** - is the general term for liquid that is used to add colour to the surface of an object by covering it with a pigmented (coloured) coating.

**Lighter tint** - when an artist adds white to a colour to create a lighter version of the colour

**Darker** - when an artist adds darker to a colour that creates a darker version of the colour.

**Shade** - A shade is where an artist adds black to a colour to darken it down

**Tone** -A tone is where an artist adds grey to a colour.
