Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1666 The fire gets very close to the Tower of London.

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 1666

St Paul's Cathedral is destroyed by the fire.

Sunday 2nd September 1666

The fire starts at around 1 a.m. Mid-morning: Samuel Pepys starts to write about the fire in his diary.

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 1666 The wind dies down and the fire spreads more slowly.

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September 1666
The fire is finally put out.
Thousands of people are
left homeless.
