

What are the similarities and differences in human and physical features between the Amazon Basin and the United Kingdom?

Vocabulary

Climate - The average weather conditions over a long period of time.

Deforestation - The cutting down and clearing of forests.

Humid - Feeling very damp due to water vapour in the air.

Weather - The specific condition on a given day.

Amazon river -The second longest river in the world.

The Amazon Basin -The area of south America that is drained by the River Amazon and its tributaries.

Canopy – Broad irregular trees grow a dense, continuous canopy of leaves 60 – 90 feet above the ground.

Emergent layer – The highest layer of the rainforest, found above the canopy.
