Key Vocabulary

Emmaus

On the road to Emmaus Jesus appears to two disciples.

Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is a person of the Trinity. God's love and presence within us, and a guide for making good choices.

Ascension

Jesus went up to Heaven.

Pentecost

The day the Holy Spirit came to Jesus' followers, giving them the power to share God's love with everyone.

Church

Glory Be

is a short prayer we say to thank God, the Father, Jesus, the Son, and the Holy Spirit for everything.

Gospel

the core message of God's love and Jesus' sacrifice through stories.
