Hello and Welcome to St Mary's Nursery,

We are delighted that you are joining us here and we are really looking forward to meeting you. Within this pack we have put together lots of key information that we think you will need before starting Nursery. Although we have tried to cover everything, please know that we are always here if you have a question, no matter how big or small.

St Mary's Nursery is a valued part of St Mary's Catholic Primary School. The nursery is joined together with Reception and Year 1, making '**Class 1**'.

In November 2025, with support from Liverpool Archdiocese, we opened a brand-new classroom for our youngest learners. It has its own outdoor area specifically tailored to the age specific needs of the children. This means that your child is able to spend time within the St Mary's School community, giving them an excellent transition on starting Primary School when the time comes.

Nursery Hours

The nursery setting is open from **9:00am – 3:00pm**. Your child may attend for full days and experience the whole curriculum or alternatively, you may wish for them to stay for just mornings or afternoons.

Morning session: **9:00am – 12:00pm**

Afternoon Session: **12:00pm – 3:00pm**

Breakfast and After School Club

Breakfast and After School Club is available for Nursery children from Monday to Friday. This will take place with the St Mary's Primary School children and is led by Mrs Charnock and Mrs Burton-Duff.

The cost of these clubs will be as follows:

Breakfast club: 7:45am – 9:00am- **£5.50**

After School Club: until 5:00pm - **£6.50**

until 6:00pm- **£8.50**

School Dinners

The school kitchen can provide a hot or cold lunch for your child each day at a cost of £2.90. This can now be ordered online in advance. Alternatively, if you prefer, your child can bring in a packed lunch and sit with their friends to enjoy this.

Snack

Your child will be offered snack twice daily which takes place as a social experience. The cost is 20p per day. We ask that you pay this at the start of the academic year online, a member of staff from the Office can help you with this if you have any problems registering online for ParentPay.

Water Bottles

Please send your child into Nursery with a water bottle labelled with their name so that this can be kept in the setting.

Uniform

As our days are full and varied with lots of activities that may sometimes include forms of messy play there is a requirement for your child to wear a school uniform. This will consist of a

white polo shirt (school logo optional) and grey skirt/pinafore/shorts/trousers. The bottoms can be purchased on the high street. Uniform can be purchased in Premier Schoolwear, Ormskirk. [St Marys Catholic Primary School Scarisbrick – Premier Sports And School Wear Ltd](#)

We also have a wonderful 'Pre-loved' Uniform section in the Main Office. Families are more than welcome to help themselves to any uniform they may require.

Other Clothing

We require you to send in a spare set of clothes in your child's bag in case of any possible 'accidents'. In addition to this, for those younger children who are still using nappies, please provide us with a bag of nappies, wipes and nappy bags for your child's use if needed.

We spend a lot of time in the outdoors at Nursery. Therefore, please send in wellies with either a waterproof coat and waterproof trousers or waterproof overalls. Please ensure all clothing is labelled with your child's name. During Summer or periods of hot weather please provide sun protection cream and a suitable hat or cap, again, labelled with your child's name.
