Key Vocabulary

Allies The United Kingdom, France and Poland, later joined by other countries, including the USSR (Soviet Union), the USA and China.

Atomic bomb A very high - energy bomb made of radioactive materials.

Axis The axis powers were originally Germany, Japan and Italy. Other countries joined them later.

Evacuation When people have to leave a dangerous area and move to a safer place.

Persecution - when a group of people are targeted and treated in a cruel or unfair way, such as changing laws to punish them or imprison them unfairly.

Rationing To limit how much of something people have, such as food and fuel.
