Skeleton The framework of bones in your body.

Exoskeleton The protective or supporting structure covering the outside of the body of many animals.

Endoskeleton The internal skeleton of an animal, especially the bony skeleton of vertebrates.

Vertebrate A creature which has a spine.

Invertebrate An animal without a backbone (spine).

Joint The function between two or more bones.

Muscle Something inside your body which connects two bones and which you use when you make a movement.
